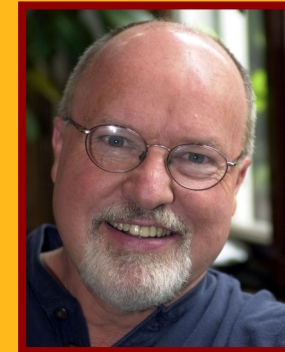

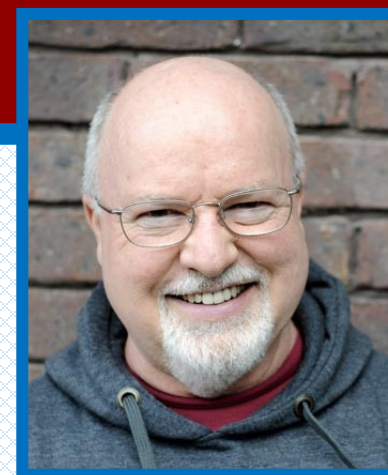

Richard Rohr, OFM, is a Franciscan priest and internationally known inspirational speaker. He is best known for his writings on spirituality and his audio and video recordings. Scripture as liberation, the integration of action and contemplation, community building, peace and justice issues, male spirituality, the Enneagram and eco-spirituality are themes that he addresses in his writing and preaching.

Fr. Rohr founded the New Jerusalem Community in Cincinnati, Ohio in 1971 and the Center for Action and Contemplation in Albuquerque, New Mexico in 1986, where he presently serves as Founding Director. He is a contributing editor and writer for *Sojourners* magazine.
