4.	Do you think that there is such a thing as "just" discrimination? Why do you think that church leaders often qualify "discrimination" with "unjust" when discussing LGBTQ issues?
5.	If you presented these teachings to a group in your parish, what do you think their reaction would be?
6.	Can you think of any ways to present these teachings so that people would be more open to them?
